By submitting an entry, a competitor further agrees that they, the owner, handler, trainer, parent, and anyone associated with exhibiting a horse at the show waives all claims against the show, show management, its employees, the facility, its owners, and employees for any injury to themselves attendants or horses/ponies. Rules and Regulations:

LP Equestrian Center Horse Show Management or "Management" reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of an incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules/Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management, with their decision final and binding. The Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries, refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to cancel or combine any classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or judges; to change specifications in dressage classes in order to facilitate the time schedule or as competition warrants, or make any changes management deems is in the best interests of the show. Every horse and rider combination entered for competition will be under the control of the horse show management, but management will, in no case, be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold LP Equestrian Center, its members, directors and employees, sponsoring entities, and facility harmless for any loss or accident to their horse, horses or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire, negligence or otherwise. USDF/USEF Rules apply. Open to ALL Breeds. Shows start times 9:00AM, but subject to change, please review ride times. Changes in ride times may be made by management after the closing date and publication of ride times. Ride times are available before the show at LP Equestrian Center Facebook & will be posted at the show.

Multiple riders are permitted to show one horse, but not to exceed a total of 2 tests per horse/rider combination or 2 tests total per horse/two riders per day. Each horse can be ridden in 2 consecutive levels.

Emergency service will be 911.

Division(s) Rules & Regulations:

Novice Rider: Rider is in the 1st or 2nd year of showing at any dressage show and may show only in this class for 2 years maximum, on any horse.

Novice Horse: Horse, with any rider, is in the 1st or 2nd year of showing at any dressage show and may show only in this class for 2 years maximum.

Junior Rider: Riders 18 and under as of January 1 of the current show year.

Adult Amateur: Riders 19 and over. Amateur refers to riders that obtain NO income from riding, training or teaching.

Open: Any age and professional.

Leadline: Open to any age rider.

If you are interested in a class we currently don't offer, please contact Violet at LPequestrianshows@gmail.com with your interest. Classes may be considered for addition.

Coggins: No entry will be accepted without a photocopy of a negative Coggins test for each horse brought to the show grounds (with the horse's name matching entry forms). A

photocopy of a negative Coggins test dated within 12 months of the closing date of entered show must be submitted with each entry form. Entries submitted without a negative coggins test will not be accepted.

Stall Fees: Stall fees are \$40.00 per stall for the weekend. A separate, refundable \$25 stall cleaning deposit is due upon entry. (Refund given upon stall inspection.) Stalls are available after 2pm on Saturday. Reservations are accepted on a “first pay, first served basis”. First bedding is not provided, but shavings are available upon request (\$8/bag or \$9 day of). **STALLIONS MUST BE STALLED.** Stalls after the closing date are non refundable in any circumstance.

Horses Showing out of Trailers: There will be a \$20.00 per day per horse tie-to-trailer fee for horses showing out of trailers.

Non-Competing horse: Horses wishing to school only must pay a non-compete fee of \$30.00.

Veterinary Care & Farrier Services: All local on-call vets & farrier services in the area will be listed on our show office bulletin board on Saturday during haul in. This is to ensure the most up to date and available services at that time.

Entries: Can be found on LP Equestrian Center FB Page or www.lp-equestrian.com and must be submitted via snail mail, email, or online form found on LP Equestrian Center website.

Entries close at 6 PM 2 WEEKS PRIOR TO THE SHOW. Payment can be submitted with a check sent to LP Equestrian Center, postmarked by the closing date, or online at lp-equestrian.com. You will be charged for all fees after this time with no refunds. There will be a \$25.00 blanket post entry fee per entry after this time.

- No entries will be taken over the phone.
- All entry forms must be completely filled out and signed.
- Checks should be made payable to LP Equestrian Center.
- All entry fees are non refundable after the closing date.
- There will be a service fee of \$40 for any non-negotiable checks.
- No class changes will be made after the closing date unless due to show management error.

Please make sure all final submissions are correct! Please call or text Violet at 586-935-7955 if you have any questions.

Protective Headgear: All riders must wear an ASTM/SEI approved riding helmet while mounted anywhere on the show grounds (professionals included). Any rider violating this rule will be immediately prohibited from further riding until the headgear is properly in place. LP Equestrian Center makes no representation or warranty, expressed or implied, about any protective headgear, and cautions riders that serious injury may result despite wearing protective headgear as all equestrian sports involve an intrinsic element of risk. Schooling will be available any show rings starting on Saturday after 2pm until ½ hour prior to

commencement on the day of the show. Management reserves the right to limit schooling in the show rings as needed. Lunging is only permitted in designated areas and is prohibited on grass and in show arenas.

Rings: 3 available; Large Outdoor, Large Indoor, & Small Outdoor

Scratches: After the closing date, cancellations for any reason are charged all fees without refund.

Dogs: Dogs must be leashed at ALL TIMES while on the show grounds (including handheld dogs). No dogs will be allowed in any schooling area, show ring, or in the secretary office.

Smoking: Is ONLY allowed in designated smoking areas. Butts must be disposed of in provided containers.

Attire: All riders MUST wear approved ASTM helmets while mounted. Boots with a heel, shirt/jacket with collar and sleeves required. Riders in Intro may show in a polo shirt with a collared neck and half chaps. Western dressage riders must wear show attire compliant with WDAA requirements. Chaps are optional.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES: The unsafe use of electronic devices, as determined by Management in their sole discretion, including cell phones, with or without earphones/buds while mounted is prohibited in all areas designated for schooling and exercise, and while lunging horses on competition grounds.

MANAGEMENT: Management reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions regarding or arising from an incident at the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by Management, their decision to be final. Management reserves the right to:

- limit, refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries.
- disqualify any riders or exhibitors.
- prohibit exhibition of entries.
- cancel award prizes without claim for damages.
- change any course and/or add a dotted line. ▪ change rings or judges.
- change specifications in jumper classes to facilitate the time schedule or as competition warrants.
- modify the prize list for clarifications as warranted.
- make any changes management deems is in the best interests of the show
- cancel, combine, or reschedule any classes after due notice to exhibitors.

BEDDING IS NOT PROVIDED: available for purchase for \$8.00/bag. Please order shavings when reserving stalls. Include payment on your entry & call / text 586-935-7955 to verify stalls tack stall & shavings. Especially, if you are mailing your entry.

LP Year End Championships Available:

Year End Champion & Reserve Champion awards are given in the following divisions provided there is a minimum of 5 riders per class/division & not if they are combined for all three shows. Horse rider combo must attend all three jumper shows.

- Junior Rider: Riders 18 and under as of January 1st of the current show year.
- Adult Amateur: Riders 19 and over. Amateur refers to riders that obtain NO income from riding, training or teaching.
- Open

AWARD RIBBONS: will be given to the horses placing 1st - 6th in all classes; classes may be combined if less than 5 riders per class/division

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

W/T classes to be shown at a walk, trot in both directions. No professionals unless otherwise noted (Hors De Concour) One rider per horse in each class. Classes with less than 6 entries may be combined.

W/T/C classes to be shown at a walk, trot, & canter in both directions. No professionals unless otherwise noted(Hors De Concour) One rider per horse in each class. Classes with less than 6 entries may be combined. Not to cross enter into W/T

POLE PILES - class is available for AA & Junior only. No professionals unless Hors De Concour.

GREEN BEAN JUMPER - Open to all horses & ponies in their first year of jumping.

CROSS POLE JUMPERS: Fence height not to exceed 18" for riders in their first year of showing.

2' JUMPERS: Fence heights 2' for riders who have not entered in fence heights over 2'3"

2'3" JUMPERS: Fence heights 2'3" for riders who have not entered in fence heights over 2'6"

2'6" JUMPERS: Fence heights 2'6" for riders who have not entered in fence heights over 2'9"

2'9" JUMPERS: Fence heights 2'9" for riders who have not entered in fence heights over 3'

3' JUMPERS: Fence heights 3" for riders who have not entered in fence heights over 3'3".

3'3" JUMPERS: riders who have not entered in fence heights over 3'6"

Jump-Off - If a rider completes their first round clear, they remain in the arena to complete a shortened course of fences called a "jump off" if needed.

RULES - please follow USEF rule book as a guideline
